The system of education at Talent Tree School, is a blend of theory and practice in the right proportion to arrive at a comprehensive curriculum. With the advent of 2024-25, mega and micro events began to roll with renewed energy. The purpose of our education is to build up the child in a holistic manner, so that our student becomes a fully rounded personality, developed in all aspects-mind, body, heart and will. - 1. Infrastructure:** Talent Tree School, governed by Talent Search Society Rohtak, is a world-class institution spread across a campus spanning about 5 acres. The institution's passion for knowledge is reinforced and enhanced by state-of-the art infrastructure and best-in-class educational facilities, including technologically advanced AC Classrooms, Language, Science, AI & Robotics and Computer laboratories with Wi Fi connectivity and Digi Classes.

The school is divided into following wings:

- **Pre-Primary Block - Nursery to U.K.G.**
 - **Primary Block - I to V**
 - **Junior Block - VI to VIII**
 - **Senior Block - IX to XII**
- 2. Cleanliness and Hygiene:** Round the clock cleanliness and hygiene is at the top priority of the school management. There are separate washrooms and drinking water areas for girls and boys taken care of by male and female support staff under their respective In-charges. They are designed as per the convenience of the students and safety norms.
 - 3. Safety and Security:** The school is under CCTV surveillance round the clock with fire extinguishers installed at reachable points. GPS tracking devices and cameras are installed in all buses and vans for security. Visitors are thoroughly investigated and record book maintained.

4. Faculty: The faculty for Scholastic and Non-Scholastic subjects is well qualified and trained as per the norms of CBSE. They attended regular workshops as organized by the CBSE Board for NEP 2020. All the faculty members are completing 50 hours of training (CPD) as per the norms of CBSE.

Teachers' Training -- Along with the activities for the students a spectrum of training programs and orientation for staff was also organised from time to time to update our faculty with latest techniques. I am glad to inform that all our faculty members will complete 50 hours of mandatory training as per NEP 2020 by the CBSE Regional Office, Panchkula.

5. Academics: The school is now affiliated to CBSE New Delhi (Bharat) and follows the curriculum from Classes PG to XII as defined by the CBSE. We have two terms – April to September and October to March. A highly effective model in education and it means “Learning by Doing”. The goal of experience-based learning involves making students identify their developmental needs and learn something significant or meaningful to support their overall evolution. It will help our students tackle difficult situations and come out with hands-on knowledge on multiple subjects. We want to ensure that all our children get personalized learning for them to be ready for real life challenges.

Education is fundamental for achieving full human potential, developing an equitable society and promoting national development. To achieve this, our child-centric methodology will concentrate on various parameters of teaching to evolve and awaken the minds of children. We will support out of the box thinking and while they truly benefit from this, it will also play a vital role in shaping the society at large.
